<p><u>Mathematics</u></p> <p>We follow a Mastery approach to teaching maths and this term we will be focussing on:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Multiplication and division</li><li>• Fractions</li><li>• Position and Direction</li><li>• Place value within 100</li><li>• Money</li><li>• Time</li></ul>	<p><u>Art</u></p> <p>We will complete a unit of work entitled 'Colour Creations'. We will learn about primary colours, light and dark and different shades and also complete a study based on Wassily Kandinsky.</p> <p><u>DT</u></p> <p>We will complete work based on our unit of work called 'Perfect Pizzas'. We will explore a range of bread based products, explore pizza toppings and design and create our own healthy pizzas.</p>	<p><u>Music</u></p> <p>The children will listen to different styles of music and learn to play and compose simple music. We will be completing the units 'Zootime' and 'Friendship'.</p> <p><u>Computing</u></p> <p>We will be looking at 'Grouping Data' and 'Digital Writing'.</p>	<p><u>PE</u></p> <p>We will be following our Complete PE Scheme. We will be completing the units 'Locomotion: Jumping Games for Understanding' and then 'Health and Wellbeing'.</p> <p><u>PSHE</u></p> <p>The children will be thinking about, 'Being my Best' and 'Growing and Changing', making use of the SCARF curriculum.</p>	<p><u>English</u></p> <p>We will be looking at non-chronological reports: Queen Elizabeth II and then moving onto writing a narrative based on the book 'The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch'. We will also be creating some poetry based on 'Sounds of the Sea'.</p> <p><u>Phonics</u></p> <p>We will continue with the 'Little Wandle for Letters and Sounds' phonics programme. We will continue bringing home our spot 'show off' books and our star books to read at home. We will continue to bring home a library book to enjoy together too.</p> <p><u>RE</u></p> <p>In Year 1 the children will be thinking about 'What is the good news Jesus brings?' and 'What makes some places in Cornwall sacred?'</p>
<p><u>Science</u></p> <p>In Science we will be completing work based on 'Plants and Animals Including Humans'. We will be visiting Feadon Farm and learning to answer a range of questions including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Can I name the different stages in a human time line?</li><li>• Can I explain what happens as a human grows?</li><li>• Can I describe the basic needs of animals for survival?</li><li>• Can I describe the importance of eating the right amounts of different types of food?</li></ul>
