

<p><u>Mathematics</u></p> <p>We follow a Mastery approach to teaching maths and this term we will be focussing on:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Multiplication and Division • Length: Perimeter • Fractions • Decimals <p><u>Science</u> <u>How Plants Grow</u></p> <p>As part of their learning, the children will find out about identifying and describing the functions of the roots of flowering plants. They will also be thinking of a test to show the way in which water is transported within plants, and identifying and describing the functions of leaves in flowering plants. The children will explore the part that flowers play in the life cycle of flowering plants, including pollination, seed formation and seed dispersal, and look at how plants disperse their seeds. Finally, they will look at the parts of a seed and why are seeds an important food source for animals.</p>	<p><u>Art</u> <u>Plant Art</u></p> <p>The children will learn to appreciate the work of different artists, develop observational skills, know how to create tints, shades and tones of colours, develop printing and create sculptures using clay.</p> <p><u>DT</u> <u>Packaging</u></p> <p>The class will investigate a range of packaging, construct nets for 3-D shaped packages, explore the use of graphics on packaging, design a packaging box for a particular purpose and make a packaging box by following a design.</p>	<p><u>Music</u></p> <p>We will follow the Charanga scheme.
