As from Thursday 5th September, we will have new catering providers for our school meals. **Aspire Catering**, headed by Jo Wotton, will be providing all of the catering for Mount Hawke Academy.

We are delighted to share that we will be keeping our existing kitchen team, led by Miss Spybey, and that our meals will remain at £2.30 per day. We will also still be using ParentPay for ordering meals and *payment (*Years 3 and above).

If your child has a food allergy, Jo Wotton would like to meet with you to discuss the new menu. Aspire Catering are more than happy to meet with any parent/carer who has a dietary need that is supported by a doctor's letter. She will be at Mount Hawke Academy on Tuesday 23rd July from 9am-10am, 12-1pm and 2-3.30pm.
