

<p><u>Mathematics</u></p> <p>We follow a Mastery approach to teaching and this term we will be focussing on:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Mass and Capacity Y3</li><li>• Decimals Y4</li><li>• Money Y3 &amp; Y4</li><li>• Time Y3 &amp; Y4</li><li>• Shape Y3 &amp; Y4</li><li>• Statistics Y3 &amp; Y4</li><li>• Position and Direction Y4</li></ul> <p><u>Science</u></p> <p><u>Animals including humans</u></p> <p>The children will be learning how to classify carnivores, herbivores and omnivores based on their diet and how animals are dependent one another. The children will then learn different types of teeth in humans and how we can keep our teeth healthy. Finally, we will focus on the functions and basic parts of the digestive system.</p> <p><u>Light and Shadow</u></p> <p>The children will learn about how light travels, what shadows are, how the length and position of a shadow changes throughout the day much more.</p> <p><u>Computing</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Programming – Repetition in Games</li></ul> <p>The children will learn skills such as infinite and count controlled loops to create their own game project</p>	<p><u>Art</u></p> <p><u>Vincent Van Gogh</u></p> <p>The children will learn to appreciate the work of Dutch artist, Vincent Van Gogh. The children will know how to use colours and lines to create shade and movement, develop their sketching techniques and create portraits in the style of Van Gogh.</p> <p><u>DT</u></p> <p><u>Moving Monsters</u></p> <p>The class will investigate a range of simple pneumatic systems in which they will gather ideas to create their own moving monster toy. Based on their testing and findings, they will create their own moving monster by following their annotated designs. Finally, they will evaluate their work to determine what went well and how they could make it even better.</p>	<p><u>Music</u></p> <p>We will follow the Charanga scheme.
