Science Challenge

Chromatography is the process of separating colour pigments.

What You	What You Do:	
Need:	1.	Take a coffee filter and mark a line two inches from the bottom.
paper towels,	2.	Fold the coffee filter in half.
peg,	3.	Decorate above the mark with markers.
tablespoon, water-soluble	4.	Pour two tablespoons of water into the cup.
markers,	5.	Fold the coffee filter in half twice and put it in the cup.
coffee filters,	6.	The colours will travel upwards on the filter! What colours can you see?
clear cup,	7.	Take the filter out, and let it unfold and dry.

What's happening?

Colours are made up of molecules! The coffee filter absorbed the liquid, and the colour molecules get dissolved. Some of these colour molecules are smaller and lighter than others, so they move at different speeds. That's why the colours look separate!
