This term we have become the first school in the country to be award with plastic Free School status for the third time from Surfers Against Sewage. Mount Hawke Academy worked together to find yet another plastic item to eliminate from our school by buying and using refillable glue sticks. Children also wrote letters to Members of Parliament to educate them on the effects of plastic pollution on our planet. Lamorna Class (our now wonderful year 5s) came up with the fantastic idea of 'Plastic Free Packed Lunches' after researching the types of plastics that are still lingering in our school. Once a month we will be holding a 'Plastic Free Packed Lunch' day where we would love all packed lunch items to be free from any SINGLE USE PLASTIC. EYFS Phonics Workshop – Find Out How We Teach Phonics and Early Reading

All Classes - Maths Workshop - Find Out How We Teach Subtraction - and visit classes

This workshop will be held on Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> October between 9.00 am and 10.00 am and is suitable for all ages. Mrs Webb, our maths lead, will talk through our teaching methods first and then you are welcome to visit classes to see maths in action.

## Census Day Menu

Next Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> October, is a National School Census Day, when the Department for Education (DfE) collects information about each school to help them plan for the future and, most importantly, the data is used to set future school budgets. One of the figures we must report is the number of Reception and Years 1 & 2 children who are having a Universal Infant Free School Meal (UIFSM) on this day.



The census data is then used to decide how much funding for the year we receive for our hot meals.

We do not receive funding for the number of hot meals we supply, only the number of meals eaten on the census days each year.

Our solution to this problem is to ask every child in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 to try the school meal (or part of it) on Census Day. Please book as usual on ParentPay but instead of the options shown for 3<sup>rd</sup> October we will be serving the popular hot dog menu, followed by chocolate brownie. Jacket potato and hot tomato pasta will also be available. Your child will then be fully funded to have hot meals during the year thus saving the school any additional costs. You are welcome to send in a packed lunch as a back-up.

The football season has started again and a team of Y5/6 and a team of Y3/4 headed off to Tregolls Academy in Truro on Monday to have their first matches as new teams. Both teams represented our school so well against great opponents, showing great sporting values and we were delighted to come away with two wins.


