His Dark Materials trilogy by Philip Pullman - Book Review by Eliza in Allen Class

Do you like fiction stories about magic? If so, you will love 'His Dark Materials-Northern Lights' by Philip Pullman. The story is set in a parallel universe where everyone has a 'daemon' which is basically their soul.

The book is about an element called 'Dust'. (It's not the stuff you find under your bed) Some people think Dust is sin, but some don't.



The main character is Lyra Belacqua. She meets a boy named Will. He can travel through thousands of slightly different worlds with a knife that can cut anything, including metal and even air! The story is set in Oxford University, but in a different world.

I really love the book, as when you get into it, it actually feels like you know the characters as real friends and as if you're really there. I would recommend this book to you if you enjoy Harry Potter and action. It has a very complicated plot, so it's probably for children around the age of 8 and older. I would rate this book ten out of ten - If you've finished the trilogy and you enjoy it as much as I do, there's another three books called The Book of Dust.
